which said property is shown on the plan annexed hereto and thereon coloured pink **HEREBY CONSENT** to the Central Electricity Board (hereinafter called "the Board") placing the electric lines and works specified in the First Schedule hereto (hereinafter referred to as "the electric lines") across and on the said property upon the conditions printed on the opposite page (which conditions shall be deemed to be incorporated herewith) and upon the Board during the time the electric lines are placed across the said property paying to the owner a yearly rent in accordance from time to time with the Second Schedule hereto the said rent to be payable on the thirtieth day of September in each year the first payment being proportioned from the date of commencing the erection of the electric lines.

FIRST SCHEDULE.

**5** conductors for transmitting electricity by 3-phase current at a frequency of 50 cycles per second and at a pressure of 132,000 volts together with an earth wire and **5** towers for supporting the same and the equipment required by the Board in connection therewith.

SECOND SCHEDULE.

For each tower . . . . . 5/- per annum.



PARISH OF KEIGHLEY.



THE CONDITIONS HEREINBEFORE REFERRED TO.

1. The expression "the erection of the electric lines" includes the erection user maintenance repair renewal inspection retention and removal of the electric lines.
2. The Board may carry out the erection of the electric lines along the route shown on the plan annexed hereto subject to such reasonable additions thereto and such reasonable deviations from the said plan as may be necessary or desirable. Provided that the conductors and earth wire shall be so placed as to be inaccessible (without the use of appliances) from any part of the said property.
3. The erection of the electric lines shall be executed by the Board subject to the provisions of the Electricity (Supply) Acts, 1882 to 1928, or any statutory modification thereof and in accordance with the Regulations of the Electricity Commissioners applicable thereto for the time being in force.
4. In addition to paying the yearly rent the Board shall—
  - (a) If the existence of the towers or equipment shall cause any interference with ploughing or with the mowing of grass pay to the owner or (if the owner is not in occupation) to the occupier compensation for such interference in accordance with the scale set out in the Schedule hereto.
  - (b) Pay to the owner or occupier compensation for any loss sustained by him in consequence of any damage caused by the electric lines or by the erection of the electric lines to the land trees hedges fences buildings crops or property of the owner or occupier or make good such damage to the reasonable satisfaction of the owner or occupier.
  - (c) Keep the owner indemnified against all actions claims costs and expenses which may be made against the owner by reason of the erection of the electric lines.
5. The Board upon giving to the owner not less than twelve calendar months' previous notice in writing to expire at any time may subject to the provisions of Condition 4 (b) and (c) hereof remove the electric lines or any part thereof and upon such removal or the expiration of such notice (whichever shall be the later) payment of the said rent shall cease in respect of the electric lines or such part thereof as may be removed.
6. This consent may be terminated at any time by the owner giving to the Board twelve calendar months' previous notice in writing, but without prejudice to the rights of the Board under Section 22 of the Electricity (Supply) Act, 1919, and Section 11 of the Electricity (Supply) Act, 1922, or under Section 21 of the Electricity (Supply) Act, 1926, as the case may be.
7. Any dispute or difference arising under this consent shall be referred to arbitration in manner provided by the Arbitration Act, 1889, or any statutory modification thereof.

SCHEDULE REFERRED TO IN THE FOREGOING CONDITIONS.

Ploughing ... ..	15/- per annum.
The mowing of grass ... ..	5/- "
